Nephi Speer was born and raised in the Bay Area, but he has never felt more at home than in Sacramento. He has been involved in a diverse array of choral, orchestral, and theatrical organizations throughout Northern California and beyond, including the Green Valley Theatre Company, Music Circus, Coro Allegro in Boston, the Graham-o-Rama

cabarets, Contra Costa Musical Theatre, and the Fantasy Forum Actors Ensemble. Nephi has also been a guest vocalist for the Sacramento Choral Society and Orchestra, the California Symphony, the Diablo Symphony Orchestra, and the Sacramento Gay Men's Chorus. As a member of Schola Cantorum under the direction of Donald Kendrick, Nephi had the opportunity to bring his musical ambassadorship to Europe, including the halls of Notre Dame, Florence Duomo, and St. Paul's Cathedral. Last September, he joined Aeternum for their debut choir concert season in Napa. Most recently Nephi sang with RSVP (Reconciliation Singers Voices of Peace).
